1:00pm-2:00pm- Presentation: Adverse Childhood Experience and Foster Care: Lessons Learned and Implications for the SLP

Circumstances that lead to placement in foster care and even the experience of foster care itself can be traumatic to children. These negative events and others, including abuse and neglect are considered adverse childhood experiences (ACEs). The emotional and physical impact that ACEs have on children can prevent expected language and learning skill development. Foster parents often lack training and knowledge to recognize and manage their foster children's fight, flight, and freeze behaviors. This session will review the neurological basis of developmental trauma, insights from a survey study about foster care parent training, and characteristics of children in foster care related to ACEs. We will discuss implications for expanding understanding and treatment of developmental trauma.

Nichole Mulvey

Nichole Mulvey is an associate professor at Eastern Illinois University in the Communication Disorders & Sciences Department. She is a former school based SLP and current early interventionist. She teaches graduate courses in early childhood and school-age language disorders and the capstone undergraduate course. She also supervises graduate students in diagnostic experiences for clients with language, literacy, and social communication deficits. Her areas of research interest are language and narrative sampling and social communication.

Beth L. Bergstrom

Beth Bergstrom is an instructor at Eastern Illinois University in the Communication Disorders & Sciences Department. She is the instructor of the courses: Cleft Lip and Palate, Pediatric Feeding, Evaluation and Therapy, and Working with Families in Early Intervention. She supervises both undergraduate and graduate students in clinical practicum. Ms. Bergstrom supervises clients with a variety of disorders, including individuals who have developmental trauma. She most recently joined the multidisciplinary evaluation team for autism at the EIU Autism Clinic. She has done presentations at the state and national level on a variety of topics.

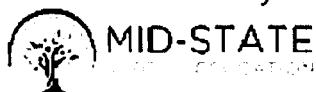
