Tip of the Week:

SHARE THE MICROPHONE



When your students give oral reports or presentations, have them use the FM microphone. If each student is contributing a remark, the microphone can be passed among the students. Remember to remind the students how to properly hold the microphone. During small groups, place the microphone in the middle of the group to pick up each member's comment. Have the DHH student's partner wear the mic during partner work. Retrieve the microphone before giving additional instruction. Share the mic with other teachers and staff working with the student throughout the day.



Trick to Try:

Give time for your students and other teachers to interact and become familiar with the mic. Think of who the students need to be listening to and make sure the mic is with the speaker(s).
