Tip of the Week:

SPEAK ONE AT A TIME



Practice speaking one at a time during lessons, questions, discussions, etc. This creates clarity for the student to focus on what is being said by the teacher and peers. Over talking or more than one person talking makes the sounds run together and overlap, making it very difficult for the student to understand. Establish a routine for turn-taking in class and during virtual class meetings.

Trick to Try:

Begin the habit of repeating what someone said before addressing the question/comment. This will give students a chance to hear again and clarify the topic.
